BACKGROUND

Reason/Objective:

1. The objective of the faculty development program was to provide an opportunity to the faculty members for upgradation of their knowledge and teaching pedagogy.

2. Another vital objective was to equip the faculty members for a smooth shift from being a teacher to a facilitator.

Conducted under: IQAC committee

- · Usefulness: The program was conducted to educate the faculty members about various innovative ways to interact with students as well as teach them the course syllabus effectively.
- Expected Outcome: The program is expected to enhance the skills of all the faculty members to innovate their teaching styles. Another expected outcome is that the faculty members will be well aware of the knowledge and skills to deal with student's problems as first responders.

BRIEF INTRODUCTION

The faculty development program was organized by the IQAC committee. The program was divided into three days and each day consisted of two sessions. On the first day, Mr. Niketan Tware taught the faculty members the use of powtoons and the importance of interacting through a YouTube channel. The second session was conducted by Dr. Avinash De Sousa. He taught the faculty members about important skills necessary for maintaining a healthy class environment as well as skills to handle student's problems. The second day consisted of two sessions conducted by Mr. Prajesh Troksky and Mr. Samrat Srivastava respectively. The first session brought to light a very important lesson apart from many others, "Every student already has the knowledge, Education is the way to draw it out." In the second session we learnt various gamification tools to make lectures more ITC enabled and interactive. On the third day, the FDP commenced with a session by Mr. Madhusudan Sohan on the topic 'Resource Management to develop E-content'. This session taught the faculty members about various ways in which recorded lectures can be stored and optimized for best results. Lastly,

we wrapped up with a rather interactive session by Mr. Prashan Pandey on Cyberbullying and Prevention. This session went beyond the said topic and covered other necessary laws and its implications in day-to-day life, the knowledge of the same proved to be very empowering. All the three days had one thing in common-rich interaction among the faculty members and resource persons.
