- Pre-submission images or videos should be carried along with the participants.
- Inappropriate and/or offensive content, including provocative nudity, violence, human rights and/ or environment violation, and/or any other content deemed to be contrary to the legal, religious, cultural, and moral traditions and practices of India, are strictly prohibited and will lead to disqualification of the participant/college.
- Participants should be present 30 minutes prior to the time specified in the schedule, latecomers will not be given any time extensions.



REGISTRATION RULES

- Registrations through online mode will begin on Thursday, 12th January, 2023 from 08.00 a.m. onwards.
- The Last date for online registration is Tuesday, 17th January, 2023 until midnight.
- Online registration will take place via Google form only.
- CLs/ACLs must present their valid ID proof (College ID-Card and/or fee receipt of the current year) at the registration desk for themselves and their respective participants wherever necessary.
- Participants should come and confirm their identity 30-45 mins prior to the commencement of the event. Here, CLs are also allowed to show participant's ID cards and confirm their identity.
- If the participant is not confirming the identity in the mentioned time, then that contingent will be disqualified from that event.
- The last date for submission of videos/images for pre-submission events is on or before Tuesday, 17th January, 2023 until 11:00 p.m.

- OTSE (On The Spot Entry) will only be permitted for a limited time period & for a limited number of participants.

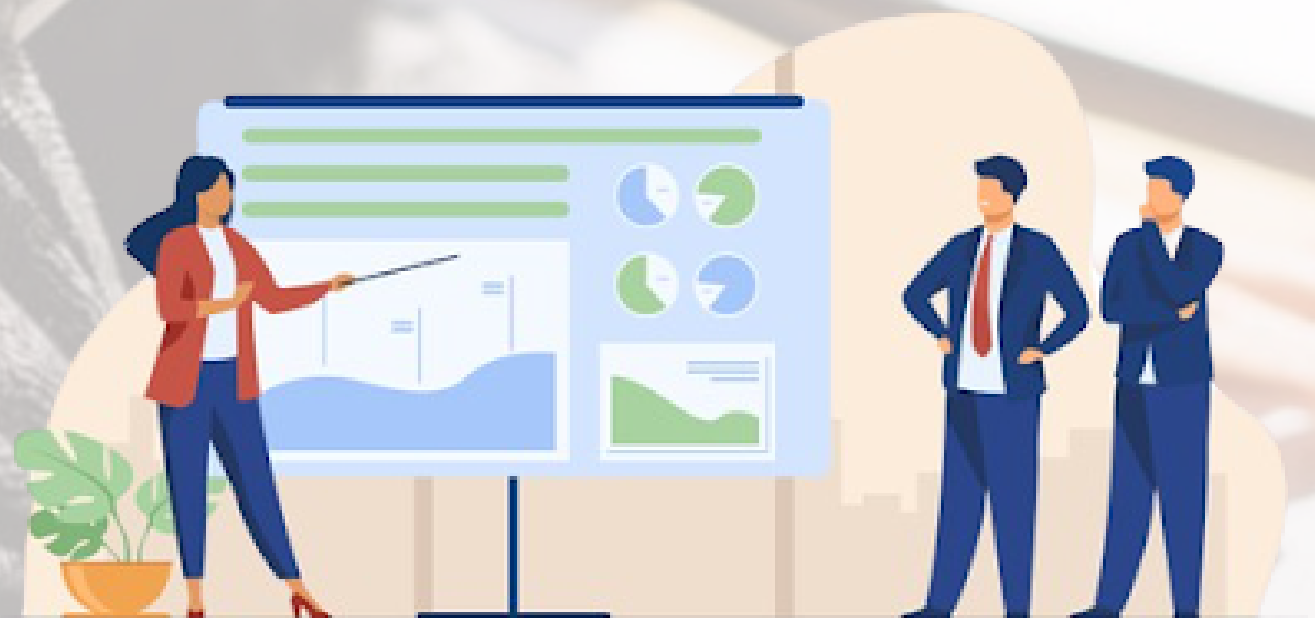
- No. of participant(s) per college: Team of 2

- Judge's decision will be final and binding.

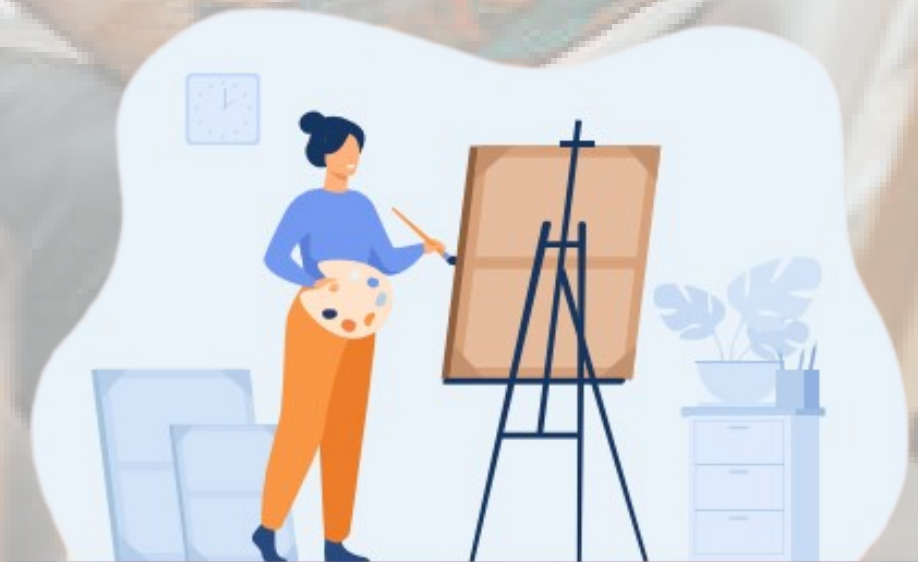

POSTER MAKING

- No. of participant(s) per college: 1
- Theme – Social awareness
- Time Limit: 2 hours
- Only A3 drawing sheet will be provided by the organizer.
- The poster should be original, hand-made using an A3 drawing sheet with a margin drawn with black pen/marker.
- Acceptable tools for drawing/painting include colored pencils, crayons, and water or oil-based colours.
- Use of photograph, 3D object, sticker, print out, stencils, reference material, etc is strictly prohibited.
- Judgement will be given on the basis of relevance of the theme, originality, creativity, colour harmony and visual impact.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.



FACE PAINTING

- No. of participant(s) per college: 1 + 1(model)
- Time Limit: 1 hour.
- Painting should be original, handmade and the surface should be limited to the face only.
- Each participant must bring all of his or her own face painting supplies including paints, brushes, rinse water for brushes, water container, sponges, sponge-tipped applicators, and other tools and supplies necessary to complete the task.
- Judges' decisions will be final and binding.





RANGOLI

- No. of participant(s) per college: 1
- Time Limit: 2 hours.
- Topics: Fusion of hues depicting social message.
- Size of the rangoli should be 3ft x 3ft.
- Rangoli should be made using rangoli powder only.
- Participants will have to bring their own material.
- Rangoli should be fully handmade.
- Use of any reference material is not allowed.
- Judgement will be given on the basis of clarity of theme, creativity & design, uniqueness & finishing and overall appearance of the art related to theme.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.





- No. of participant(s) per college: 1
- Time Limit: 1 hour.
- Theme : Open
- Further rules will be disclosed on the spot.
- Material: Any eco-friendly/Reusable/Recyclable material. Participants will have to bring their own material.
- Judgement will be given on the basis of creativity & uniqueness, materials used, quality of artistic composition & design, and overall impression of the art.

MANDALA ART

- No. of participant(s) per college: 1
- Time Limit: 1 hour
- Theme: Open
- Participants will have to bring their own materials such as acrylic paints, pens, pencils, etc.
- Participants will be judged on symmetry, neatness, intricacy level, uniqueness, and overall impression of the art.
- Mandala base will be provided by the organizer.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding



MEHENDI

- No. of participant(s) per college: 1 + 1(model)
- Time Limit: 1 hour
- Theme: Indo-Arabic
- The participants have to draw the mehendi on the palmer side of one hand & around three inches above the palm.
- The model should be a student of the same college.
- The participant has to bring their own mehendi cone.
- Use of a hand print, any kind of reference or mold, or decorative material is not allowed.
- Judgement will be given on the basis of creativity & design, uniqueness, finishing & detailing.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.





NAIL ART

- No. of participant(s) per college 1+1(model).
- Time Limit: 1 hour.
- Participants should bring their own materials.
- Stickers are not allowed.
- Extensions are allowed.
- Judgement will be given on the basis of originality, creativity & design, colour harmony, visual impact and overall look.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.



TATTOO MAKING

- No. of participant(s) per college 1+1(model)
- Time Limit: 1 hour
- Participants should bring their own materials.
- Stickers, stencils, reference materials are not allowed.
- Colour pens/markers are allowed.
- Judgement will be given on the basis of originality, creativity & design, colour harmony, visual impact and overall look.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

FACE OFF DANCE

- No. of participant(s) per college: 1
- Rules & Regulations will be declared on the day of event.
- Costumes & make-up are allowed. Costumes should be decent and appropriate.
- Performance should not convey any indecent gestures.
- Any kind of fireworks, flammable activity, or activity related to water, etc. is not allowed.
- Judges' decision will be final and binding.





GROUP DANCE

- No. of participant(s) per college: Team of Min 6 and Max 10.
- Time Duration: 4-6 minutes
- Theme :- Open
- Team Nirvaan appreciates the inclusion of theme fusion hungama in the dance performance.
- Maximum 2 accompanists are allowed to assist their participants off stage.
- It is the responsibility of the participating college to remove their sets, property, etc. within two minutes after their performance.
- Track of the songs should be submitted to the organizer when demanded in the required format.
- Costumes/make-up/props are allowed. Costumes should be decent.
- Dance performance should not convey any indecent gestures.
- Any kind of firework, flammable activity, or activity related to water, etc is not allowed.
- Any form of vulgarity or profanity will not be tolerated and will lead to disqualification.
- Organizing team is not responsible for any kind of loss/theft or damage of valuables and belongings of the participating team.

SOLO SINGING

- Song composition should be based on the theme: Indian Vibes with a Western Twist (remix of English & Hindi/Marathi)
- The participant may play a musical instrument if required.
- Karaoke tracks are allowed. It should be submitted to the organizer when demanded in the required format.
- Songs should not offend any religious or cultural sentiments.
- Any form of vulgarity or profanity will not be tolerated and will lead to disqualification.
- Organizing team is not responsible for any kind of loss or damage of valuables and belongings of the performing / participating team.
- Judges' decision will be final and binding.





MONO-ACTING

- No. of participant(s) per college: 1
- Topic :- 1. 75th years of Independence
2. Bollywood
- Time Limit: 5-7 mins
- The computation of time shall start immediately after the final announcement by the organizer.
- Costumes/make-up/props are allowed.
- Participants will use English, Hindi or Marathi languages only.
- Judging will be done on the basis of acting skills, confidence, performance style and expressions.
- Any form of vulgarity or profanity will not be tolerated and will lead to disqualification.
- Organizing team is not responsible for any kind of loss/theft or damage of valuables and belongings of the performing / participating team.
- Judge's decision will be final and binding.



STREET PLAY

- No. of participant(s) per college: Team of 6-10.
- Duration of the performance-: 8 to 10 minutes.
- Max 2 accompanists are allowed in this event.
- The use of props is allowed.
- The skit should preferably highlight an issue of national/social importance.
- Participating team is allowed to use English, Hindi, or Marathi Languages only.
- The play should not hurt any religious or cultural sentiments and should not include profanity, obscenity, or vulgarity.
- Judge's decision will be final and binding on all participants.



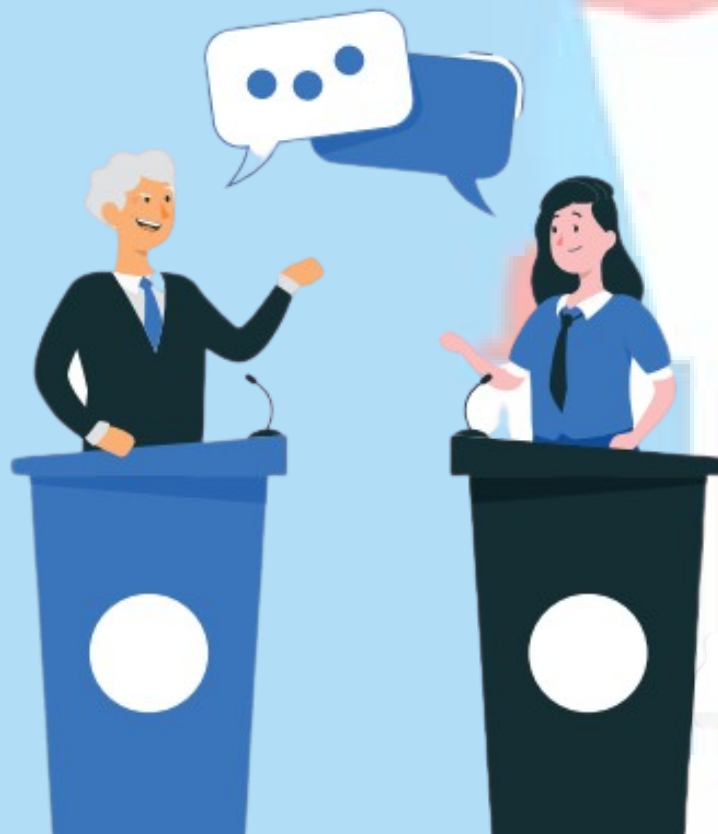

- No. of participant(s) per college: Group of 8-10
- Time Limit: 8-10 minutes
- Theme: Indo-western
- Profanity, Vulgarity, and obscenity will lead to disqualification.
- The use of props is allowed.
- Judges' will be final and binding.





- No. of participant(s) per college: 1
- Time Limit: 5-10 mins.
- At least 3 tracks or more should be played by the contestant within the allotted time.

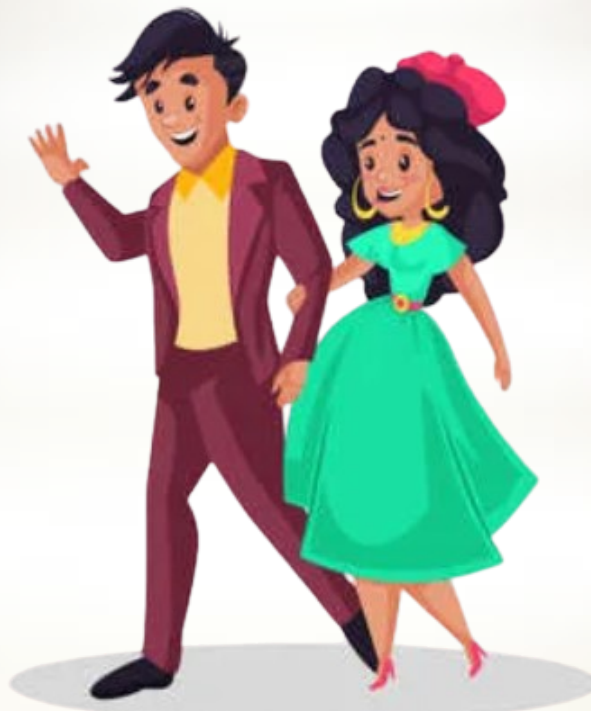
BEST PHYSIQUE

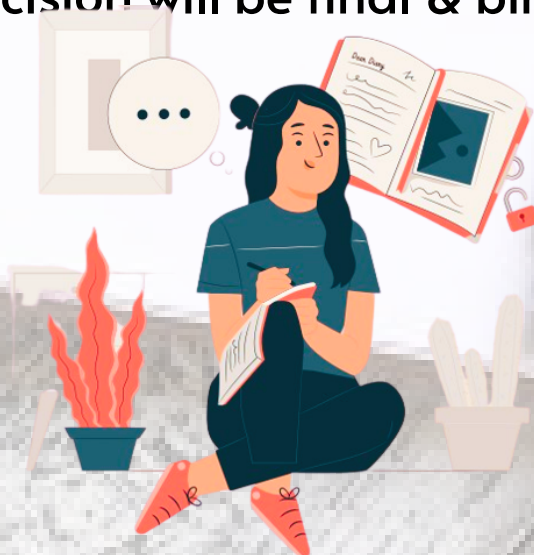
ELOCUTION

- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.



CREATIVE WRITING

- No. of participant(s) per college: 1
- Time limit: 1 hour.
- Participants can choose any one of the following category i.e. blog writing or fiction writing.
- Topics will be disclosed on the spot.
- Participant has to adhere to the concept of a featured story or a blog.
- Participants should make use of relevant keywords and highlight the same.
- Word limit is 750-1000.
- No profanity, vulgarity, or adult content will be tolerated. Avoid using popular personalities.
- Create your own personal character.
- Only full-scaped ruled paper will be provided by the organizers.
- Judges' decision will be final & binding.



STORY TELLING

- No. of participant(s) per college: 1
- Time Limit: 5-7 mins.
- Computation of time shall start immediately after the final announcement by the organizer.
- The story to be presented by the participant can be authentic, adapted, or originally written.
- The story can be presented in Hindi, English or Marathi only.
- Sensitive issues such as religious sentiment, stereotyping, politics, etc. should be avoided.
- Use of background music, properties and reference materials is not allowed during the performance.

2-Day Event of Performing Arts-Solasta

BACKGROUND




